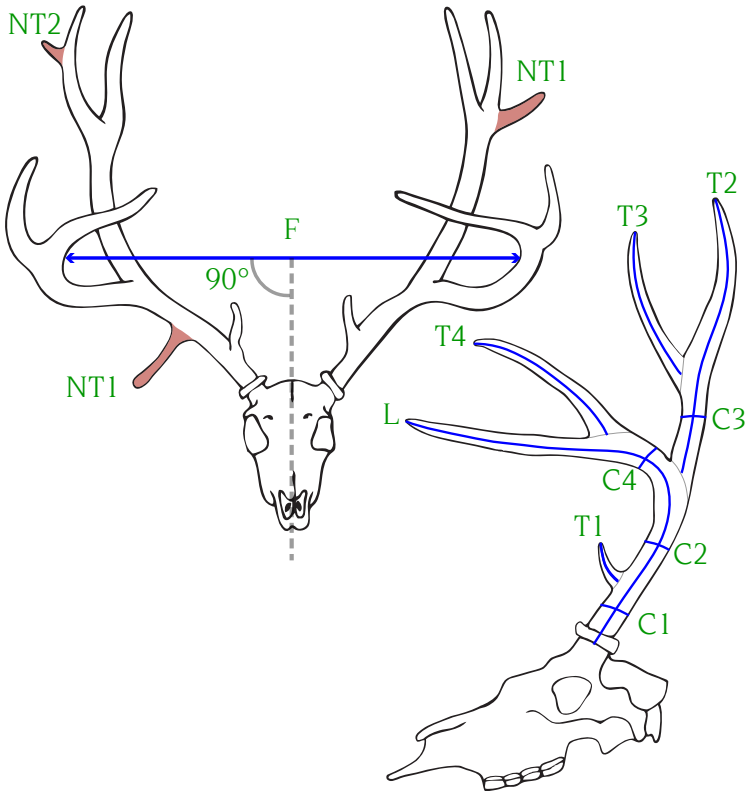

Method 1-e Mule Deer, Sitka Deer and Black-Tailed Deer

Length: Measure the main beam antler on the center of the outside curve from the lowest edge of the burr to the tip. **(L)** The tape must not be pressed into the groove above the burr. The main beam is that part of the antler that curves forward and is closest to the skull.

Circumference: Always measure the smallest circumference; **(C1)** between the burr and T1, **(C2)** after the eye guard but before T2 branches off, **(C3)** between the main beam and before the T3 branches off and the **C4** is measured between the T4 and T2. All circumferences are taken between typical tines and not between NT tines.

Typical Tines: All tines must be inch or more, mark all tines with a base line, measure from the point to the center of the base. Start with the 1st tine (eye guard, **T1**) and progress along the main beam **(T2, T3 and T4.)**

Inside Span: Measure the widest distance between the main beams (not any tines) at a right angle to the long axis of the skull. **(F)**
The sum of the above is the score for a typical mule deer, (C on the Method Form), but any non-typical tines must be recorded, see below.

Non-typical Tines: Measure the length of all non-typical tines of 1 inch or more, starting from the burr and working up. **(NT1, NT2, NT3, etc.)** For typical mule deer trophies, they do not count toward the score, but must be recorded. To determine if a mule deer falls in the non-typical category: take the non-typical score (D on the method form) and if it is 3% or more of the typical score (C on the method form) the trophy will be placed in the non-typical category.

Count the number of typical tines including main antler.

Count the number of non-typical tines including the main antler.

Photos: Clear, focused side- and front-view "in-the-field" photos must accompany all animals. Digital photos must be a minimum of 300DPI (12 dots per mm) or 2100 x 1500 pixels. If not in the top 10 the following animals are exempted; blesbok, Southern bush duiker, klippringer, steenbok, springbok, Cape hartebeest, Southern impala, common gemsbok, common and southern mountain reedbucks, common sable, Chobe & South African bushbucks, Cape eland, S. Greater kudu, nyala, common waterbuck, blue & black wildebeests, Cape buffalo, introduced fallow deer, bushpig, warthog.

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
