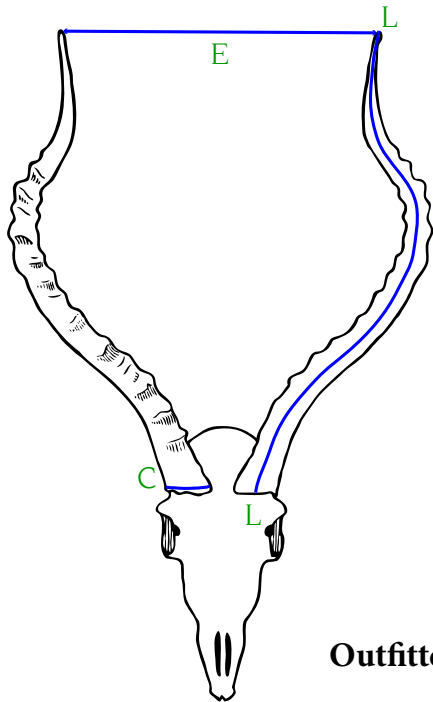




Method 7-a

All African, Asian Antelopes and Gazelles with Simple, Non-spiraled Horns; Damaliscs, Forest and Bush Duikers; Dwarf Antelopes; Gazelles; Hartebeest; Impala; Kob; Lechwe; Oryx and Gemsbok; Reedbuck; Rhebok; Roan and Sable; Waterbuck. ANTELOPES NOT MEASURED under 7a are addax, blackbuck, Wildebeest, Gnu and all African spiral horns.

Record all duiker, dik-dik, rhebok and dwarf antelope in fractions of 1/16.

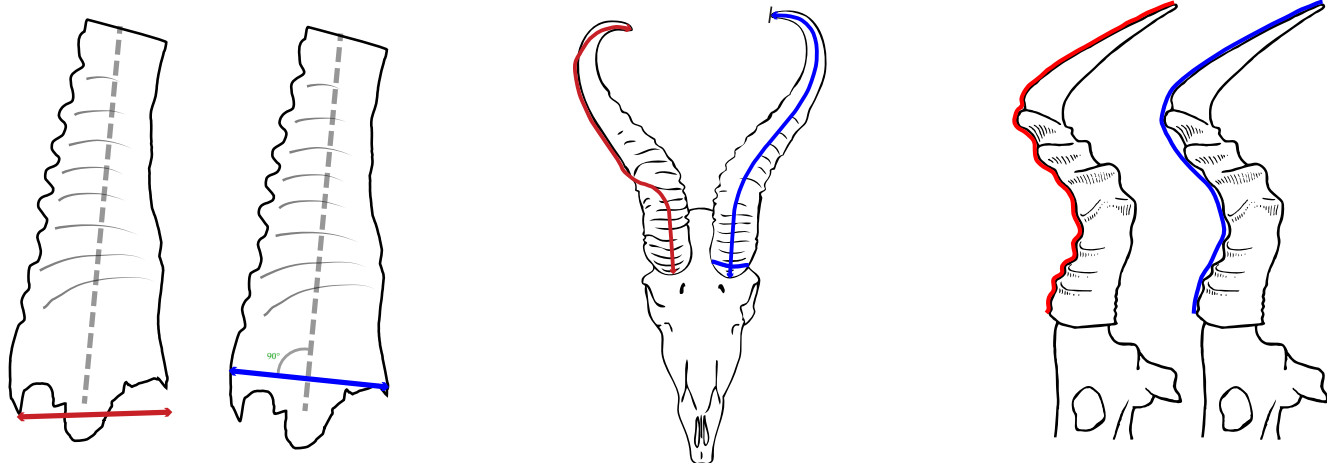
Method 7-a

Reedbucks use Method 7-a. Do not measure/record the circumference of the bases. Measure length without including the "green" or soft/pulp material. Record all duiker, dik-dik, rhebok and dwarf antelope in fractions of 1/16.

Length: Measure in the center of the front curve from the lowest edge of the base to the tip. **(L)** Do not press the tape into any ribs or depressions. Stay on the front of the horns and do not slide off to the outer side.

Circumference: Measure the circumference of the base of each horn at a 90-degree angle to the axis of the horn whilst staying on or over horn material at all times. **(C)**

Tip to Tip: Measure the Tip to Tip spread from the center of one horn tip to the other. **(E)** REQUIRED

If not in the top 10 the following animals are exempted; blesbok, Southern bush duiker, klipspringer, steenbok, springbok, Cape hartebeest, Southern impala, common gemsbok, common and southern mountain reedbucks, common sable, Chobe & South African bushbucks, Cape eland, S. Greater kudu, nyala, common waterbuck, blue & black wildebeests, Cape buffalo, introduced fallow deer, bushpig, warthog.
