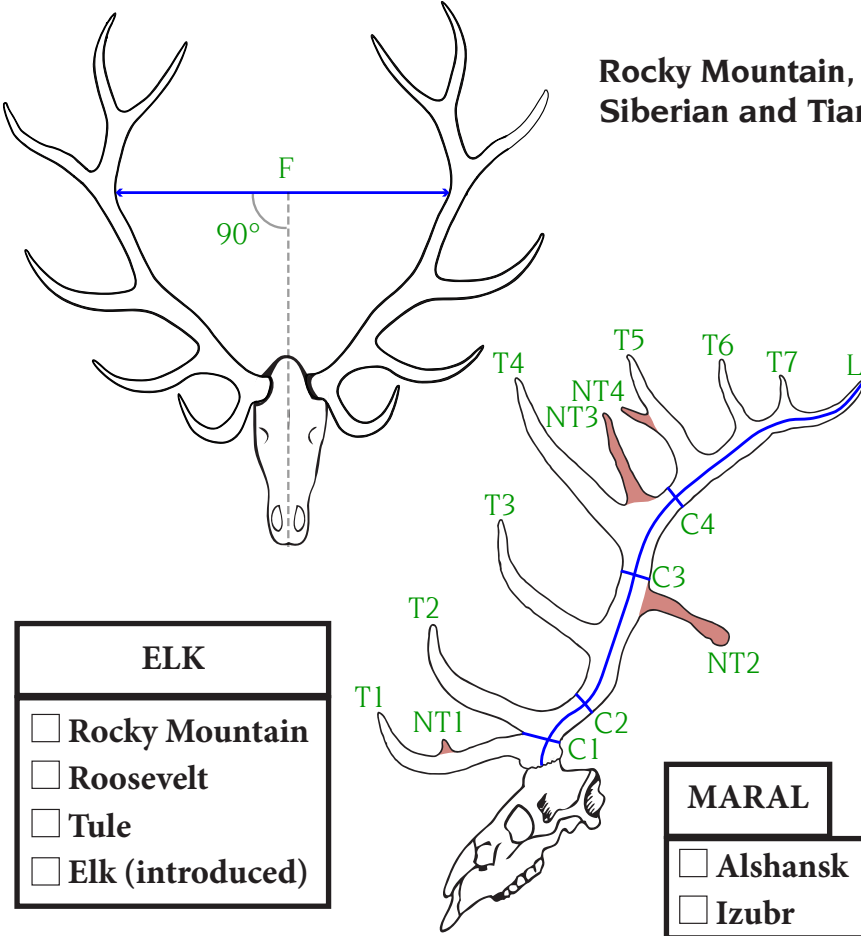

## Method 1-a

### Rocky Mountain, Roosevelt, and Tule Elk. Alshansk, Izubr, Siberian and Tian Shan maral

**Length:** Measure the main beam antler on the center of the outside curve from the lowest edge of the burr to the tip. **(L)** The tape must not be pressed into the groove above the burr. The main beam end (tip) is normally the most rearward point.

**Circumference:** Measure the smallest circumference between the **T1 and T2, T2 and T3, T3 and T4** and finally **T4 and T5. (C1, C2, C3, C4) Circumferences** can only be taken between typical tines. Place the total of the main beam length and the circumferences in A on the Method Form.

**Typical Tines:** Mark off all tines along the base. Measure the length of all typical tines of 1 inch or more with a base that is smaller than the tine length. Starting with the brow **(T1)** and work towards the tip. Measure from the point of the tine to the center of the baseline. **(T1, T2, T3, etc.)** Typical tines project from the main beam; forward **(T1)**, sideward **(T2, T3)**, and upward for the T4 and beyond. If a tine grows in a different direction, it is not typical. Place the total of all typical tines in B.

**Span:** Measure the widest distance between the center of the main beam antlers (not any tines) at a 90-degree angle to the long axis of the skull. **(F)** Place the measurement in C.

**Nontypical Tines:** Measure the length of all non-typical tines of 1 inch or more with a base that is smaller than the tine length. Start with the tine nearest to the burr and work towards the tip. **(NT1, NT2, NT3)**. Non-typical tines grow sideways from the main beam, backwards and are tines off a tine. See Handbook for details. Place the total in E.

**Rocky Mountain elk:** take the non-typical score (E on the method form) and if it is 3% or more of the typical score (D on the method form) the trophy will be placed in the non-typical Rocky Mountain elk category. If not, it falls in the typical category.

**Roosevelt elk, Tule elk and Alshansk, Izubr, Siberian and Tian Shan marals:** add the D and E on the method form. This is the total score for the trophy. There are no non-typical categories.

**Weight:** Weigh the cleaned and boiled skull and antlers. Record whether the skull has been cut or not. (Supplemental)

**Photos:** Clear, focused side- and front-view "in-the-field" photos must accompany all animals. Digital photos must be a minimum of 300DPI (12 dots per mm) or 2100 x 1500 pixels. If not in the top 10 the following animals are exempted; blesbok, Southern bush duiker, klipspringer, steenbok, springbok, Cape hartebeest, Southern impala, common gemsbok, common and southern mountain reedbucks, common sable, Chobe & South African bushbucks, Cape eland, S. Greater kudu, nyala, common waterbuck, blue & black wildebeests, Cape buffalo, introduced fallow deer, bushpig, warthog.

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
