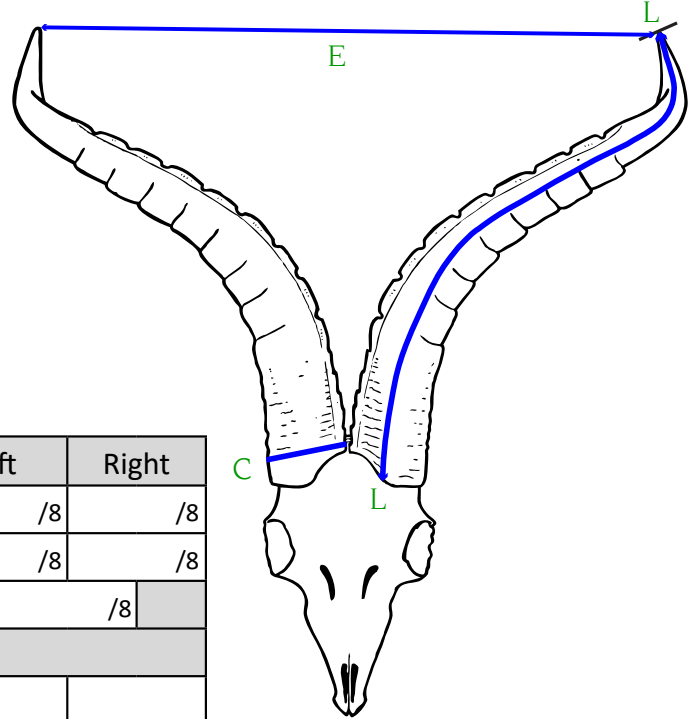

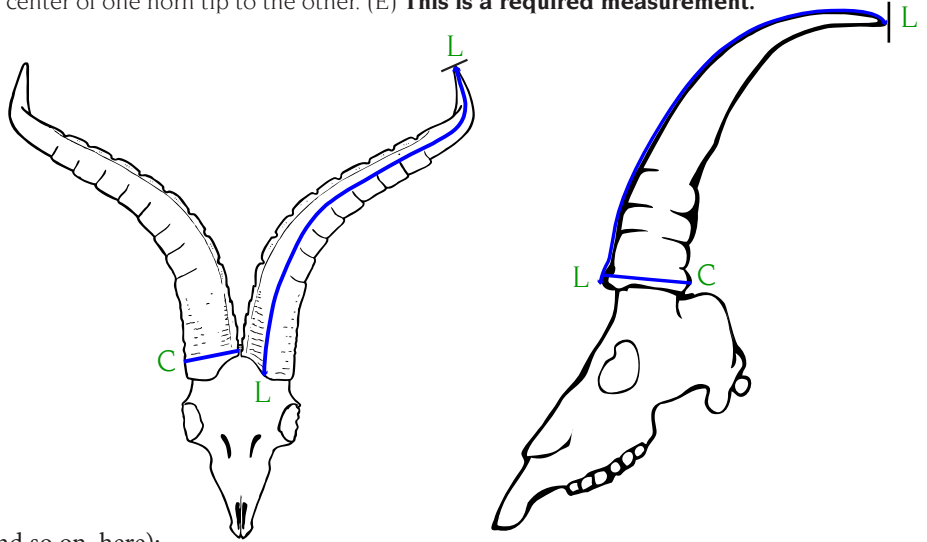

Method 7-b

Bezoar (Pasang), Chamois, true Ibex, Goral, Serow, Rocky Mtn. Goat, Spanish Ibex, Tahr, Western (and Central) Tur.

- Length:** Measure in the center of the front curve from the lowest edge of the base to the tip. Stay on front & center of the horn. Follow the grain. (L)
- Circumference:** Measure the base of each horn. (C) The tape must form a continuous loop over horn material, take this measurement as close to the base as possible but keeping the tape at a 90-degree angle to the axis of the horn.
- Tip to Tip:** Measure the Tip to Tip spread from the center of one horn tip to the other. (E) **This is a required measurement.**
- Growth Rings:** Count the number on both horns.
