ROWLAND WARD SUPPORTS SUSTAINABLE, FAIR-CHASE HUNTING THAT BENEFITS LOCAL INDIGENOUS PEOPLE AND THE CONSERVATION OF WILDLIFE AND ITS HABITAT.



CURRENT PROGRAMS

CANADA – DRIFTWOOD VALLEY OUTFITTERS, supports an apprenticeship multi-year program empowering at risk indigenous youth building careers in the hunting and outdoor industry while preserving cultural heritage of the Takla nation.

CAMEROON – MAYO OLDIRI SAFARIS, supports anti-poaching efforts, educating local communities and reducing illegal poaching activities, as well as infrastructure projects, including a medical center renovation, school upgrades and support to the Mayo Rey Hospital.

CONGO – CONGO FOREST SAFARIS, supports anti-poaching, local education and conservation. By providing school supplies and teaching the value of local wildlife, the program helps students understand how protecting nature directly benefits their community.

PAKISTAN – AKHUWAT, supports a remote learning school near Hingol National Park, this community-based conservation program includes lessons on wildlife conservation and its value to the local community.

ZAMBIA – NTENGU SAFARIS, supports a beehive initiative reducing tree-bark poaching and deforestation in communities near protected hunting areas. By sponsoring bee hives made from commercial wood planks rather than tree bark, the project offers a traditional livelihood that protects mature hardwood forests with a side benefit of curbing illegal bushmeat trade.

ZIMBABWE – ZIMBABWE BIO-ENERGY (ZBE), supports an initiative at the Nuanetsi Ranch through advanced leopard monitoring, highlighting the vital role of sustainable sport hunting in long-term wildlife conservation.

RECORDS OF BIG GAME

Rowland Ward Records of Big Game is the oldest record book in existence (since 1892).

It maintains a comprehensive database, with very high minimums for entry, of animals from all over the world hunted strictly under Fair Chase conditions.
