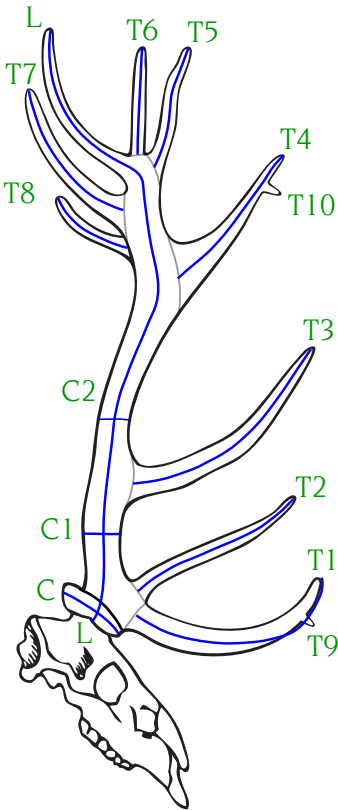

Method 1-b

Asian and European Red Deer. Includes all red deer from Europe, Asia Minor (Turkey), the entire Caucasus Mountains, and all of Asia. Also includes introduced red deer from the South Pacific and South America.

Length: Measure the main antler on the center of the outside curve from the lowest edge of the burr to the tip. (L) The tape must not be pressed into the groove above the burr.

Circumference: Measure (C) the circumference of the burr. Measure (C1), the smallest circumference between the bez (T2) and the trez (T3) and measure (C2) between the trez (T3) and the next main point above it. Do not measure C1 and C2 between minor (nontypical) points.

Tines: Measure the length of all tines of 1 inch or more, starting with the brow and working up. Measure from the main antler to its farthest extending point. (T1, T2, T3, etc.)

Inside Span: Measure the widest distance between the main antlers (not any tines) at a right angle to the long axis of the skull. This must be done below the crown. (F)

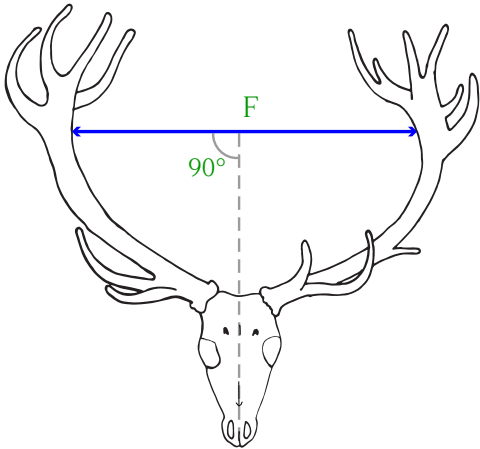
No of Points: Count all valid tines including the main antlers.

Weight: Weigh the cleaned and boiled skull and antlers. (Supplemental)

Cut: Record whether the skull has been cut or not. (Supplemental)

CIC Points: Submit endorsed form. (Supplemental)
