

Method 19

Crocodiles and Alligators

General remarks: Rowland Ward measures crocodilians in a straight line between the pegs and **NOT** following the contour line of the body from nose to tail.

This is a field measurement and must be taken before skinning. It is a measurement of the total body length, including the length of the tail. Do not measure a skinned crocodile because fresh, green skin stretches considerably. This measurement can be taken by the professional hunter and a witness if an official Rowland Ward measurer is not available. A length from fresh or raw skins, dried, cured, or tanned skins will not be accepted as considerable stretching will occur. Measure to the nearest quarter-inch.

Length: Lay the crocodile on a flat piece of terrain. This is important in order to get a proper measurement. Pull the nose and tail of the reptile into a straight line, and then drive in pegs at each end. Make sure the pegs are at a 90-degree angle to the ground. Remove the crocodile. Take the measurement between pegs. Do not measure over the contours of the body of the animal. See red line in Figure 1. The terrain must be flat and the tape measure must not be pushed into depressions.

Note that Nile crocodiles may also be entered by skull measurements. See Method Form 18. The Nile crocodile is the only crocodilian for which skull measurements are accepted; the same animal may be entered both under method 18 and 19.
